Alexander Eisenschmidt (curator), David Brown, Studio Gang, Stanley Tigerman, and UrbanLab in a conversation about the work on view in the exhibition *City Works* and their ideas for Chicago's urban future. Previously shown at the 13th International Architecture Biennale in Venice (2012), the exhibition is now on display at the city's Expo 72 Gallery until September 29th. It re-visions a series of urban environments that are typical for Chicago in order to examine alternatives to the way architecture engages the city. The installation involves large models of planning scenarios for the city as well as an encompassing panorama drawing of a visionary Chicago.

The event is hosted by AIA Chicago and the Chicago Cultural Center and will be moderated by Zurich Esposito. Admission is FREE.
